### • Rabbit Anti-VDAC3 Polyclonal Antibody, Biotin conjugated

Conjugated Primary Antibodies

#### Background:

The Voltage-Dependant Anion Channel (VDAC3) of the outer mitochondrial membrane, a small abundant protein found in all eukaryotic kingdoms, forms a voltage-gated pore when incorporated into planar lipid bilayers. VDAC is also the site of binding of the metabolic enzymes hexokinase and glycerol kinase to the mitochondrion in what may be a significant metabolic regulatory interaction. VDAC3 is involved specifically in translocation of adenine nucleotides through the outer membrane.

**Purification:** Was purified by Protein A and peptide affinity chromatography.

#### Storage:

Prepared as lyophilized powder and shipped on ice. Store at -20°C for one year as lyophilized powder or liquid. Please reconstitute before use.

#### Reconstitution:

If the antibody is in liquid form, no reconstitution needed.

Reconstitution is only required for the lyophilized antibody. Please refer to the reconstitution instruction card in the package.
