Activates the ADP-ribosyltransferase (exoS) activity of bacterial origin. 14-3-3 proteins are localized in neurons, and are axonally transported to the nerve terminals. They may be also present, at lower levels, in various other eukaryotic tissues. It belongs to the 14-3-3 family. This antibody is reactive with 14-3-3 Alpha/Beta/Gamma/Delta/Epsilon.


Purification: Was purified by Protein A and peptide affinity chromatography.


