Conjugated Primary Antibodies

Background:

This gene encodes an integral membrane protein responsible for controlling the gradients of Na+ and K+ across the membrane. This enzyme is composed of two subunits, a large catalytic subunit (alpha) and a smaller glycoprotein subunit (beta). The beta subunit regulates, through assembly of alpha/beta heterodimers, the number of sodium pumps transported to the plasma membrane. The beta 2 subunit exhibits virtual identity with the glial cell adhesion molecule AMOG.

Purification: Was purified by Protein A and peptide affinity chromatography.

Storage: Prepared as lyophilized powder or liquid and shipped on ice. Store at -20°C for one year.

Reconstitution:

If the antibody is in liquid form, no reconstitution needed.

Reconstitution is only required for the lyophilized antibody. Please refer to the reconstitution instruction card in the package.
