• Rabbit Anti-CD166 Polyclonal Antibody, FITC conjugated

Conjugated Primary Antibodies

Background:

CD166 is a member of the Ig superfamily and is expressed on activated T-cells, B cells and other cells including thymic epithelial cells, fibroblasts, keratinocytes and neurons. CD6 has been identified as a receptor for CD166. The expression of CD166 is up-regulated in low-grade prostate tumors and down-regulated in high-grade tumors; may play role in progression of prostate cancer.

Purification: Was purified by Protein A and peptide affinity chromatography.

Storage:

Aqueous buffered solution containing 100ug/ml BSA, 50% glycerol and less than 0.09% sodium azide. Store at -20°C for 12 months. Protect from light. [Product without BSA and/or sodium azide is available for special order.]

Reconstitution:

If the antibody is in liquid form, no reconstitution needed.

Reconstitution is only required for the lyophilized antibody. Please refer to the reconstitution instruction card in the package.

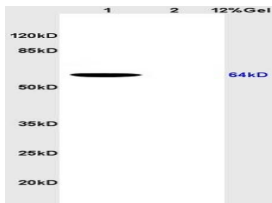
