# Rabbit Anti-CD158a/KIR2DL1 Polyclonal Antibody

Primary Antibodies

## Background:

The KIR family consists of transmembrane glycoproteins of the Ig superfamily expressed on natural killer (NK) cells and a subset of human T cells. KIR2DL1 is a receptor on human NK cells for HLA-C alleles. It inhibits the activity of NK cells thus preventing cell lysis.

#### Source/Purification:

KLH conjugated synthetic peptide derived from human CD158a. Was purified by Protein A and peptide affinity chromatography.

Storage: Prepared as lyophilized powder or liquid and shipped on ice. Store at -20°C for one year.

#### Reconstitution:

If the antibody is in liquid form, no reconstitution needed.

Reconstitution is only required for the lyophilized antibody. Please refer to the reconstitution instruction card in the package.
