Conjugated Primary Antibodies

Background:

The human TNIP2 (also known as ABIN-2), which is related to proteins ABIN-1 and ABIN-3, was originally identified as an A20-associating cytosolic protein that block nuclear factor kappaB (NF- κ B) activation. NF- κ B plays a central role in the regulation of genes implicated in immune responses, inflammatory processes, and apoptotic cell death and the zinc finger protein A20 is a potent inhibitor of NF- κ B activity with a key role in limiting the extent and duration of inflammatory activation. It was also reported that ABIN-2 has the potential to enter the nucleus and plays a role in mediating transcriptional activation in both yeast and mammalian cells.

Purification: Was purified by Protein A and peptide affinity chromatography.

Storage:

Prepared as lyophilized powder and shipped on ice. Store at -20°C for one year as lyophilized powder or liquid. Please reconstitute before use.

Reconstitution:

If the antibody is in liquid form, no reconstitution needed.

Reconstitution is only required for the lyophilized antibody. Please refer to the reconstitution instruction card in the package.
